



Please don't use an electric screwdriver!





Please don't screw straight into the plaster!




Note: It is the installer's responsibility to ensure the ceiling surface is sufficiently strong to support the weight of the luminaire and frame.

Please liaise with a builder if you are unsure.







Fit a support bracket to one short side only




Fit the frame into the ceiling opening, bracket end first



Fit the other 3 support brackets and tighten them






ONLY if the ceiling is over 37mm thick


First bend over the tab on side of Frame




It's OK to screw into timber or metal if it's right next to the Frame



DON'T screw into timber or metal if it isn't right next to the Frame!



If necessary, use a piece of metal strapping to support the Frame to the building structure
